


# **DESIGN FOR CREATIVE INNOVATION**

Partner of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Nantes, L'École de design Nantes Atlantique is a private institution for higher education dedicated to design professions, in association with Nantes Université. Founded in 1988 and recognized by the State, the school is a non-profit organization.

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique is an active member of various academic networks and professional organizations: Conférence des Grandes Écoles (top-tier French higher education institutions), Campus France and has been awarded the "Bienvenue en France" label by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs.



L'École de design Nantes Atlantique becomes in Januray 2022 the first independent design school to receive the EESPIG label (private higher education institution of general interest).

# DESIGN EXPERTISE by L'ÉCOLE DE DESIGN

Our main duty is to teach design either via standard curriculum work-based programs or via continuing education, with 1,750 students in September 2022.

As a professional school, L'École de design Nantes Atlantique has built a pedagogical program based upon close ties with companies to facilitate the professional integration of our alumni. The research activity within our Design Labs dedicated to innovation, ensures the expertise required for a postgraduate degree in design.

### DESIGN RESEARCH by L'ÉCOLE DE DESIGN

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique centers its expertise on socio-economic issues, by combining teaching, experimental research and support with innovation, within its Design Labs which develop design research programs within dedicated chairs.

# DESIGN STRATEGY by L'ÉCOLE DE DESIGN

The school also carries out a mission of services to companies and promotion of design: internships, apprenticeship contracts, prospective studies, collaborative projects, organization of thematic events, tutoring and advice.

For many years, our students have been awarded prizes in prestigious competitions. The successful careers pursued by our graduates are a good proof of the quality of our teaching methods.

# DIPLÔME DE DESIGN BAC+5,

A STATE-RECOGNIZED MASTER'S DEGREE IN DESIGN The *Diplôme de design* is based on a five-year curriculum, divided into two cycles:

- > **BDes**, a three-year undergraduate course
- > MDes, a two-year postgraduate course

The Master's degree from L'École de design Nantes Atlantique is certified by the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research since 2002, and confers the "Grade de Master" since 2021. This degree is also registered in the French directory for vocational qualifications (France Compétences) as a Level 7 Master's degree.



# **DN MADE,** <u>A STATE-CONTROLLED UNDERGRADUATE DIPLOMA</u>

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique also delivers the DN MADE, National Diploma in Fine Arts, Crafts and Design. The DN MADE leads to the award of a bachelor degree after three years of studies.

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique is located in Nantes, the 6th biggest city in France, located 50 km from the Atlantic Ocean and two hours by train from Paris. Well recognized for its quality of life, Nantes is also known for its economic dynamism, vibrant cultural life and support for contemporary creation, and was awarded European Capital of Innovation in 2019 by the European Commission.



# L'ÉCOLE DE DESIGN NANTES ATLANTIQUE IN THE HEART OF THE CREATIVE DISTRICT

The school is located in the city center of Nantes, in the heart of the Creative district. This unique site offers a working area of 11,500m2, in a building specially designed to meet the school's needs and which represents the largest real estate investment in France in the last ten years in the field of design.

The main building is open to students from Monday to Friday, from 7:45 am till 10 pm.






# JOB PLACEMENT OF OUR GRADUATES

# PREPARATORY PROGRAM FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

### A CULTURAL IMMERSION PROGRAM WITH L'ÉCOLE DE DESIGN NANTES ATLANTIQUE'S EXPERTISE

This cultural adaptation class and opening to the different design professions has been specifically designed for French-speaking international students who wish to begin design studies in a program taught in French.

This Arts, Design & Media preparatory class allows students to explore the specificities of creation with courses in modes of expression, general culture and technical culture, and to discover the different design professions: Space Design, Graphic Design, Interactive Design and Product Design, while improving their level of French with courses in French as a foreign language.

This program also offers support in preparing for the entrance exams of the most prestigious French schools, via the national Parcoursup procedure or directly with the schools concerned.

This program is open to applicants holding a high school diploma. A French level equivalent to B1 assessed by a TCF1 or DELF2 test is required to join the program.

# **DN MADE** NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN FINE ARTS, CRAFTS AND DESIGN



# A STATE-CONTROLLED UNDERGRADUATE DIPLOMA

The DN MADE, National Diploma in Fine Arts, Crafts and Design is a state-controlled degree and leads to the award of an Undergraduate Diploma after three years of studies.

Depending on the speciality, graduates of the DNMADE can work as design assistants in a design studio, in agencies, in SME/SMIs, work as freelancers or access a job as an artisan

designer mastering advanced techniques.

The DN MADE promotes links between design/creation and production/manufacturing. Centered around a common curriculum, training is built around project dynamics.

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique is the only private design school in France delivering this state-controlled diploma.



# DN MADE PROGRAMS TAUGHT IN FRENCH

The DN MADE is based on a three-year curriculum:

- > 1st year: Acquisition of the fundamental conceptual, artistic and technical tools of the chosen field
- > 2nd year: Deepening of the chosen specialty
- · 3rd year: Perfecting the chosen speciality

The DN MADE courses are organised around major and minor mentions and specialities.

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique offers 4 DN MADE Programs :

DN MADE in Digital Design with a speciality in Interface Design and Digital media, and a minor in Graphic Design

DN MADE in Space Design with a speciality in Interior Architecture and Retail, and a minor in Product Design

DN MADE in Product Design with a speciality in Industrial Product Design, and a minor in Materials

DN MADE in Fashion Design with a speciality in Design and Innovation, and a minor in Materials



The first two years are entirely taught in French, in the 3rd year, students have the choice to continue as an apprentice in a French speaking program or to study in English in an International Class.

Students holding a high school diploma and a French level B2 may join the first year. If you want to pursue design studies in France, but you do not yet have a B2 level in French, you might be interested in our preparatory program (more information page 13).

# 3 RD YEAR OF DN MADE



### ONE-YEAR IN AN INTERNATIONAL CLASS TO VALIDATE THE DN MADE, NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN FINE ARTS, CRAFTS AND DESIGN, A STATE RECOGNIZED UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE

Our international DN MADE programs welcome French and international students who have completed two years of design studies and wish to obtain a French undergraduate degree,

in the third and final year of the curriculum.

The teaching is organized around three main areas: generic culture and humanities, cross-disciplinary teaching and practical and professional teaching. Throughout the year, our students will work on various workshops, including an international workshop supervised by teachers from our partner schools, and will also develop a personal project that will be the subject of a final oral exam.

This international class offers our students the opportunity to follow a program taught in English, to cooperate with international exchange students for a semester on group projects supervised by professional designers, and to evolve in an intercultural context.

Students from all over the world who have completed a minimum of two years in design are eligible to apply, and join one of the three programs offered depending on their previous studies.

## **DN MADE** DIGITAL MEDIA DESIGN

Within this program, the digital designer is involved in the various phases of the design of a digital interactive product or service, from information architecture and scripting to the creation of mock-ups or functional prototypes, including the graphic definition of interfaces and the user experience.

Specifically tailored for students with an academic background in Graphic Design, UI/UX Design or Multimedia Design.

### **DN MADE** RETAIL & INTERIOR DESIGN

This DN MADE program proposes a specialization in the design of spaces in all fields: public or private, collective or individual, perennial or temporary; through projects concerning housing, commercial spaces, work or leisure spaces.

Specifically tailored for students with an academic background in Space Design, Interior Design or Scenography.

### **DN MADE** INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS

This program offers a specialization in the fields of industrial design. Product design is a design activity concerning consumer goods (household appliances, cars, furniture, packaging, homeware, etc), as well as capital goods (professional equipment, tools, public transport, street furniture, etc.), whether they are manufactured on an industrial scale or by craft production.

Specifically tailored for students with an academic background in Product Design or Industrial Design.



### A STATE-RECOGNIZED MASTER'S DEGREE

The Diplôme de design is based on a five-year curriculum, divided into two parts: a 3-year bachelor level course (BDes) combining creativity, collaboration and collective emulation and a 2-year master level course (MDes) focusing on the strategic dimension of design with project management and a real transversality.

Throughout the five-year curriculum, the school prepares students to experiment, to fail and to try again, to discover the different design professions, to develop their ability to manage a global project, to acquire project management skills around socio-economic themes.

This degree allows students to acquire a first international experience, and the recognition of the degree offers interesting career development prospects in the short and medium term.

The Diplôme de design (Master's degree in design) has obtained certification from the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research since 2002, and confers the "Grade de Master" since 2021. This degree is also registered in the French directory for vocational qualifications (France Compétences) as a Level 7 Master's degree.



# UNDERGRADUATE COURSE

# TAUGHT IN FRENCH

The undergraduate course taught in French is organized over three years, as the first part of the five-year curriculum

The 1st year of undergraduate studies is dedicated to the basic learning of design and creation. Practical workshops in Graphic Design, Space Design, UI/UX Design and Product Design allow students to become familiar with the different design professions.

Program taught in French, open to applicants holding a high school diploma and a French level B2.

# From the 2nd year, students choose from 4 design fields with specialisation in the form of options organized over 2 years (2nd and 3rd year of undergraduate studies).



# A UNIQUE DEGREE WITH THEMATIC PROGRAMS

All the MDes programs offered by L'École de design Nantes Atlantique lead to the Master of Design (Diplôme de design) certified by the Ministry of Higher Education.

Our MDes programs are a continuation of the undergraduate course and are organized around thematic approach. Thus, students from different fields of study work in multidisciplinary teams.

For international students holding a Bachelor's Degree in design or equivalent, the school offers: , an international postgraduate program MDes International Design Strategy / Le Studio France, taught in English in Nantes and organized around cross-disciplinary socio-economic issues linked to our Design Labs.

• 6 MDes International Design Strategy programs taught in our international Studios in Belgium, Benin, Brazil, Canada, China & India.

# WHY CHOOSE OUR PROGRAMS?

Completing a MDes program at L'École de design Nantes Atlantique means:

- > Obtaining an internationally and nationally recognized qualification<sup>(1)</sup>;
- The opportunity of a two-year international immersion in one of our studios in France, Belgium, Benin, Brazil, Canada, China and India;
- Access to the corporate world through the alumni network, the school partnerships with companies and the innovation and design centers;
- > Opening to the world of research within the Design Labs and the associated research chairs;
- The possibility of completing knowledge and developing additional skills during the fifth year thanks to the double degrees<sup>(2)</sup> (entirely taught in French);
- The guarantee of acquiring a technical expertise in innovation in the areas covered by the MDes programs and gaining the management skills required for a young designer.

# **GENERAL COURSE OUTLINE**

The MDes programs courses are completed over two years, divided into 4 semesters and follow the same framework.

### SEMESTER 1: INTEGRATION, INTERNSHIP OR EXCHANGE

International and French students who did not attend undergraduate studies at L'École de design Nantes Atlantique, join the school for a 1st semester designed to assist them in adapting to their new cultural and study environment.

Students who completed their undergraduate studies at L'École de design Nantes Atlantique will spend their first semester abroad, either as an exchange student or on an internship.

All students enrolled in our International Studios are required to take an orientation seminar followed by an internship, preferably in Belgium, Benin, Brazil, Canada, China or India, depending on the chosen program.

# SEMESTER 2: TOPIC-RELATED PROJECTS

During this semester, students learn to manage complex design projects; to broaden their knowledge of the economic, social and cultural aspects of their chosen program; to create and to apply a methodology; and to prepare their final degree project, on a topic of their choice, but related to their field of studies.

Teaching is carried out in the form of projects in collaboration with industry partners, workshops, lectures, conferences and professional meetings.

### SEMESTER 3: END OF STUDIES PROJECT AND DISSERTATION

Continuation and finalization of the final degree project, which brings together all of the professional skills acquired. This can be carried out in collaboration with either a partner company and/or research laboratory of a partner university.

Supervision is ensured by means of workshops lead by an appointed design consultant, who is accompanied occasionally by external contributors.

### SEMESTER 4: INTERNSHIP

The study program is finalized with a four to six-month internship within a company, either in France or abroad.

Interns work as junior designers and are responsible for either an entire project, or part of a project.

### OBTAINING THE DEGREE

Continuous assessment and final defense + a TOEIC score of at least 800 points.

# LANGUAGE COURSES

- > French courses are offered to non French-speaking students during the first 2 semesters.
- > English courses are offered to students who have not obtained a score of 800 points or higher in the TOEIC exam.
- > Mandarin Chinese courses are offered to students enrolled in the China Studio.
- > Portuguese courses are offred to students enrolled in the Brazil Studio.

Students will have the opportunity to hone their skills through inspiring design projects.

The goal is to prepare adaptable and well-rounded design professionals who can address a wide range of design projects in a fast-changing world.

# AN OPPORTUNITY TO UPDATE YOUR SKILLS

Part of the curriculum is composed of elective courses and projects that will enable students to customize courses to their needs.

A variety of software courses, technical courses, soft skills development courses as well a design projects in different areas of design (Care Design, City Design, Digital Design, Food Design, Media Design) are offered.

# THE FIRST STEP TOWARDS YOUR PROFESSIONAL LIFE

With several projects carried out every year in close collaboration with companies or institutions as well as a 4- to 6-month internship during the second year, the MDes International Design strategy program is aimed at building up experience of real work situations in the design field.

A one-year long end of study project and thesis will also allow students to better define their identity and values as designers.

MDes Food Design	focusing on issues related to the evolution of food systems.
MDes Media Design	<ul> <li>exploring the hybridization of narratives mobilizing scenography,</li> <li>visual communication and Digital Media.</li> </ul>

Benin is undergoing rapid development of its territory and the digital transition of its companies, placing urban planning and societal design at the heart of the Africa Studio's challenges.

# AVAILABLE PROGRAMS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

Exchange students may join L'École de design Nantes Atlantique for one semester taught in English at either undergraduate level in the International DN MADE (3rd year of the bachelor studies), or at postgraduate level in one of our MDes programs in Nantes.

Only students from our partner schools are allowed to apply for an exchange program.

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique has been awarded the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) for the period 2021-2027 by the European Commission, which is a prerequisite for European higher education institutions to participate in the Erasmus+ Program.

### UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL

#### International DN MADE

Exchange students, who have completed at least two years of studies in either product, spatial, graphic or visual communication design, can enroll in one of our international DN MADE, depending on their profile:

- DN MADE Industrial Products for students with a background in Product or Industrial Design
- DN MADE Retail & Interior Design for students with a background in Space Design, Interior Design or Scenography
- DN MADE Digital Media Design for students with a background in Interaction Design or Multimedia



### POSTGRADUATE LEVEL: MASTER IN DESIGN (MDes) PROGRAMS

Exchange students, who have completed a bachelor (three or four years) in either Product Design, Space Design, Graphic Design or Interaction Design, can enroll in our MDes program taught in English and join our MDes International Design Strategy / Le Studio France.

# WHO CAN APPLY

Only students from our partner schools are allowed to apply for an exchange semester.

### HOW TO APPLY

Applicants must first be nominated by their home institution.

### APPLICATIONS CALENDAR

Courses are divided into two semesters:

- > Fall semester: deadline to apply is mid-May
- > Spring semester: deadline to apply is mid-November (only available for bachelor exchange students)

### SELECTION PROCESS

Application file review focusing on the quality of the student's portfolio and application documents

### RESULTS

Students will be notified of the result of the selection procedure within 2 weeks after the application deadline.

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# **PREPARING YOUR STAY**

# **ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES**

### VISAS FOR NON-EUROPEAN STUDENTS

If your stay in France lasts for more than three months, you will need to obtain a long-term student visa before your arrival in France. The request for the form must be made at least 3 months before your departure.

International students can apply for an online visa on France-Visas. This service is accessible to students applying for a long stay visa living in a country where visa application is outsourced and available online.

If online application is not available in your country, the request for the form must be made at the French embassy or consulate in your country of residence at least 3 months before your departure or at your local Campus France.

# CVEC (CONTRIBUTION VIE ÉTUDIANTE ET DE CAMPUS)

All students must pay the "Contribution à la vie étudiante et de campus" (CVEC) a tax that validates their registration in a higher education institution. This contribution, collected by the CROUS (Regional Centers of University and Schools) is intended to promote the reception and social support, health, culture and sports of students.

The CVEC for the academic year 2022/2023 is 95€.

Exchange students are not subject to the CVEC. Students with a Campus France scholarship are exempted from paying the CVEC but must go online anyway and download their certificate free of charge.

# HEALTH INSURANCE

In France, enrolment in higher education allows for membership to the French social security system.

The French social security is now free for all international students.

We recommend you to sign up for a top-up health insurance policy after your arrival in France.

# **COME TO SCHOOL**

## BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

The TAN, Nantes' transport company, runs a network of buses and tramways all over and around the city. Two lines serve the school:

- tramway line 1 (Chantiers Navals stop)
- busway 6 (Prairie au Duc stop)

### BY BIKE

For those who prefer soft mobility, the city has many bicycle paths. A bicycle parking lot is located in front of the school Two "bicloo" self-service bicycle stations are located near the school:

- Machine de l'île
- Prairie au Duc

# **EATING ON CAMPUS**

The school is located 100 meters from a student social catering center managed by the « Centres Régionaux des Oeuvres Universitaires et Scolaires (CROUS »).

It is also possible to eat at one of the many food outlets in the Quartier de la Création, such as the new Food Hall.

Finally, the school cafeteria is equipped with microwave ovens and snack machines.

# BUDGET

International students wishing to study in France are required to prove that they have resources above a minimum threshold level recommended by the French Ministry of Welfare (Ministère des Affaires Sociales).

The official minimum resource threshold is €615 per month, though some French embassies and consulates may require more when examining visa applications.

- Accommodation: between €300 to €600,
- Food: a minimum monthly budget would be somewhere between
   €200 to €250.
- , Transport: The TAN runs a network of buses.and trams all over the city.
- , Annual Pass (under 26 years old): €227 (10 installments of €22.70)
- Annual Pass (over 26 years old): €500 (10 installments of €50).



# **INTERNSHIPS**

The regulations around internships and financial compensations are strict in France. For every internship exceeding 44 days, interns must receive a minimum wage that amounts to approximately €540 per month.

It is not possible for exchange students to obtain an internship agreement from the school.

# SERVICES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

# ACCOMMODATION

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique grants students access to the school's housing platform Studapart that will greatly facilitate your search for accommodation in Nantes. Real estate agencies, or rooms in private homes, are available close to the school.

# UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique has a partnership with the CROUS, which manages the university halls of residence. A certain number of rooms in nearby student residences are reserved by the school for international students (attributed on demand).

# **BUDDY SERVICE**

International students can be allocated a buddy/mentor to help them settle into and adapt to their life in France.

Mentors are a point of contact before the arrival of the student and can, depending on their availability, meet students when they arrive in Nantes. They continue to be a helping hand to international students throughout the semester.

Mentors are all volunteer students (French and international) who have already spent at least one year at school and in Nantes. They are the best guides and are very enthusiastic to welcome new international students to Nantes.

# FEEL FRANÇAIS PLATFORM

Feel Français is a single platform which offers a wide range of services to help international students settle into their new lives in France, including finding accommodation, opening up a bank account, buying a phone card, applying for a visa, housing benefits, health insurance, transport and electricity. Feel Français is dedicated to making living and studying in France as easy as possible. Thanks to the school's partnership with Feel Francais students receive access to the platform once they are accepted to the school and are accompanied with the steps during the orientation week.
