DIPLÔME DE DESIGN

MASTER'S DEGREE

The Diplôme de design (Master's degree in design) is certified by the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research and leads to the award of the "Grade de Master". It is also registered in the Registre National des Certifications Professionnelles (the French directory for vocational qualifications or RNCP) as a Level 7 Master's degree.

This five-year degree is structured around a three-year undergraduate course taught in French, combining creativity, collaboration and collective emulation, and a two-year postgraduate course focusing on the strategic dimension of design with project management and real transversality. The curriculum allows students to acquire a first international experience, and the recognition of the degree offers interesting career development prospects in the short and medium term.

UNDERGRADUATE COURSE

TAUGHT IN FRENCH

Our three-year BDes programs aim to develop creativity and general culture, and to gain a solid professional culture in a design field.

- 1st year of undergraduate studies dedicated to the basic learning of design and creation.
 Open to applicants holding a high school diploma and a French level B2.
- 2nd and 3rd year levels of undergraduate studies: students choose from 8 specializations organized over 2 years.
- BDes Digital Design
 UI/UX Design or Game Experience Design
- BDes Graphic Design
 Graphic Design or Motion Design
- BDes Space DesignInterior Design or Scenography
- BDes Industrial Design
 Transport Design or Product Design

Open after completion of one year in design and a French Level B2.

DN MADE

NATIONAL DIPLOMA IN FINE ARTS. **CRAFTS AND DESIGN**

The DN MADE, National Diploma in Fine Arts, Crafts and Design is a state-controlled degree and leads to the award of an Undergraduate Diploma after three years of studies.

The DN MADE courses are organized around major and minor mentions and specialities and are based on a three-year curriculum. L'École de design Nantes Atlantique offers 4 DN MADE programs:

- DN MADE Digital Design
- DN MADE Fashion Design
- DN MADE Space Design
- DN MADE Product Design

The first two years are entirely taught in French, therefore students holding a high school diploma and a French level B2 may join the first year.

The 3rd year is taught in English.



- Our international DN MADE programs welcome French and international students who have completed two years of design studies and wish to obtain a French Undergraduate Diploma, in the third (which is the last) year of the curriculum.

L'École de design Nantes Atlantique offers 3 international DN MADE programs taught in English:



> Specifically tailored to students with an academic background in Graphic Design, Ux/Ui Design or Multimedia Design.

DN MADE RETAIL & INTERIOR DESIGN

> Specifically tailored to students with an academic background in Space Design, Interior Design or Scenography.

DN MADE INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS

> Specifically tailored to students with an academic background in Product Design or Industrial Design.







ARTS, DESIGN & MEDIA: PREPARATORY PROGRAM

A one-year program to prepare French-speaking international students to join undergraduate studies in Arts, Design & Media.

This Arts, Design & Media preparatory class allows students to explore the specificities of creation with courses in modes of expression, general culture and technical culture, and to discover the different design professions: Space Design, Graphic Design, Interactive Design and Product Design, while improving their level of French with courses in French as a foreign language.

This program also offers support in preparing for the entrance exams of the most prestigious French schools, via the national Parcoursup procedure or directly with the schools concerned.



HOW TO APPLY

The selection process is organized as follows:

- 1. Online application and payment of a non-refundable registration fee of € 50;
- 2. Uploading all the required documents for application;
- 3. Application file review;
- 4. If your application is accepted, an interview will be organized.

For the Preparatory program Arts, Design & Media, selection based on application file only.
